# **Question:**

Since 1 January 2015:

- 1897. How much has been spent by each department and agency on the government (Ministers / Parliamentary Secretaries) stationery requirements in your portfolio to date?
  - a) Detail the items provided to the minister's office.
  - b) Please specify how many reams of paper have been supplied to the Minister's office.
- 1898. How much has been spent on departmental stationary requirements to date.
- 1899. Has any customised stationery been requested or provided to the Minister or Ministerial Staff? If yes, please include a photo/scan, detail the type of stationery, date it was requested, date it was provided and the cost.

#### **Answer:**

Since 1 January 2015:

- 1897. The ATO did not incur stationery costs for the Treasury Portfolio Ministers.
- 1898. The ATO (including the Australian Charities and Not-for-Profits Commission, the Australian Business Register and the Tax Practitioners Board) has spent \$1.2M (GST exclusive) on stationery.
