Question:

- 1) Is there a wi-fi network on the department/agency premises?
- 2) If yes:
 - a. Who provides the wi-fi network?
 - b. What is the cost of operating and maintaining the wi-fi network?
 - c. What is the speed of the wi-fi network, for both uploads and downloads?
 - d. What level of security is the wi-fi network set to?
 - e. What access protocols are in place to access the wi-fi network?
 - f. Who can access the wi-fi network?
 - g. With what electronic devices can the network be accessed? Can personal devices of staff access the network?

Answer:

- 1) Yes.
- 2) a. The WiFi networks are part of the ACCC's internal ICT infrastructure. Internet connectivity is through iiNet.
- b. Approximately \$10,000 per year.
- c. Each office has its own internet plan with cost and speeds that vary depending on the location. The maximum download speed is 24Mbps and maximum upload speed is 2Mbps.
- d. Unclassified.
- e. Users are required to login to the network using their ACCC network credentials.
- f. All staff.
- g. Staff can use any wireless device, including personal devices.
