**Question:**

- 1) Is there a wi-fi network on the department/agency premises?
- 2) If yes:
  - a. Who provides the wi-fi network?
  - b. What is the cost of operating and maintaining the wi-fi network?
  - c. What is the speed of the wi-fi network, for both uploads and downloads?
  - d. What level of security is the wi-fi network set to?
  - e. What access protocols are in place to access the wi-fi network?
  - f. Who can access the wi-fi network?
  - g. With what electronic devices can the network be accessed? Can personal devices of staff access the network?

**Answer:**

- 1) Yes
- 2)
  - a. ASIC IT
  - b. \$36,000 (GST exclusive) per annum for hardware and software maintenance and support, plus 0.25 FTE (approximately \$30,000 GST exclusive)
  - c. Network speed - 802.11ac. 250mbps shared
  - d. Level of security is wpa2 enterprise with CAPWAP tunnel
  - e. Access protocol used is TCP/IP
  - f. The Wi-Fi network can be accessed by approved ASIC staff
  - g. The Wi-Fi network can be accessed by Wi-fi enabled ASIC corporate owned device including iPhones, tablets, and laptops. BYOD is supported with appropriate approvals. Guest Wi-fi is provided for some public areas.
