Ouestion:

1) Does the ABS have up-to-date or latest figures on the completion rate of the Census?

- 2) When will final response rates be known?
- 3) How does this compare to previous Census years?

Answer:

- 1. On 12 October 2016 the Australian Bureau of Statistics (ABS) announced that the preliminary response rate for the Census is over 96 per cent.
- 2. The ABS will release final dwelling response rates on 11 April 2017.
- 3. The release of final dwelling response rates on 11 April 2017 is over two months earlier than in previous Censuses. With the traditional 2011 Census model a preliminary response rate was not available and thus a direct comparison cannot be made. The final response rate in 2006 was 95.8% and in 2011 was 96.5%.
