Question:

1) What was the reason for 2015-16 FBO figure for receipts from fringe benefits tax being \$132 million lower than estimated than at the May 2016 budget?

2) What occurred in the less than two months to the end of June 2016 that caused this decrease?

3) How does the 2015-16 FBO result compare to the estimates in the 2012-13, 2013-14, 2014-15 and 2015-16 Budgets?

Answer:

1) Fringe benefits tax receipts were \$132 million below the 2016-17 Budget estimate, reflecting lower-than-expected on-assessment collections due in May.
