### **Question:**

1) What was the reason for 2015-16 FBO figure for receipts from total individuals and other withholding taxes being \$1.3 billion lower than estimated than at the May 2016 budget?

- 2) What occurred in the less than two months to the end of June 2016 that caused this decrease?
- 3) How does the 2015-16 FBO result compare to the estimates in the 2012-13, 2013-14, 2014-15 and 2015-16 Budgets?

#### **Answer:**

1) Receipts from total individuals and other withholding taxes were \$1.3 billion below the 2016-17 Budget estimate. This primarily reflected weaker-than-expected tax withheld for employees of large companies late in the year (monthly tax information is only available the month after the tax is collected).

Lower-than-expected payments on assessment and higher-than-expected refunds related to 2014-15 income year returns also contributed to the outcome.
