## Question:

1) How many mobile phones are there in use by employees?
2) With which telecommunications service provider are the mobile phones linked to?
3) What is the cost of the plan for each mobile phone?
4) How much data is included in this plan?
5) What is the cost if data usage goes beyond its quota?
6) Have there been instances where data usage for individual mobile phone users has exceeded its quota?
a. If so, can you detail the costs incurred as a result for the 2015-16 financial year, and the 2016-17 financial year to date.

## Answer:

AASB

- Number: 3 staff currently have mobile phones \& 2 phones are unassigned (due to staff leaving) on the AASB account)
- Provider: Telstra
- Cost of Plans : $1 \mathrm{X} \$ 50$ Business Plan, 2 X $\$ 80$ Business Plan, 1 X \$85 Business Plan \& $1 \mathrm{X} \$ 105$ Business Plan.
- Data \& Excess Cost:
a. $\$ 50$ plan has $4 \mathrm{~GB} \quad$ Excess is 3 cents per MB
b. $\$ 80$ plan has 1.5 GB Excess is 10 cents per MB
c. $\$ 85$ plan has 1.5 GB Excess is 3 cents per MB
d. $\$ 105$ plan has 3.0 GB Excess is 3 cents per MB
- Additional costs: None incurred for exceeding the data usage as per the plan


## AUSB

- Number: 1 staff currently has a mobile phone
- Provider: Telstra
- Cost of Plan : 1 X $\$ 135$ Business Plan
- Data \& Excess Cost: $\$ 135$ Business Plan Excess is 3 cents per MB
- Additional costs: None incurred for exceeding the data usage as per the plan.
