Section 35 and 36 of the Australian Education Regulation

Question

In relation to section 35 and 36 of the Australian Education Regulation:

- a. Is the Department confident that all states, territories and school systems are compliant with these sections? Or that they will be compliant?
- b. For each of these sections, what is the day that this report was required or is required to be given to the Secretary?
- c. The Regulation requires the department to collect information about each school's base funding under the Australian Education Act and the Gonski loadings from s35 of the Australian Education Act Does the Department currently hold this information? Can the Department provide it for each school showing the base funding and the loadings under the Australian education Act?

Answer

- a. The department has no reason to believe states, territories and non-government school approved authorities will not be compliant with section 35 or 36 of the Australian Education Regulation 2013.
- b. Approved authorities for government and non-government schools are required to satisfy sections 35 and 36 of the Regulation respectively. This has been requested to be done by 30 June 2015.
- c. No state or territory has provided this information at present and therefore the department does not currently hold this information.
