Nanny Pilot

Question

Service providers for the nanny pilot were required to provide the Department with a Schedule of Fees that they would charge families. Please provide copies of all the schedules provided to the department by the successful service providers.

- (a) What is the average cost per hour charged by these service providers?
- (b) What is the lowest, and what is the highest, hourly rate offered by provider before the subsidy?
- (c) One provider in the pilot, Charlton Brown, in Queensland, lists the cost of its professional nannies as starting from \$35.90 per hour, for a minimum three-hour session. Does that match the fee schedule provided to the Department?

Premium Service (Labour Hire)

Professional Nannies: Charge out rates are per hour based on your job description including: the number and age of children and specific duties for the Nanny or Educator. Rates start from \$35.90, a minimum of 3-hour session.
