## Taxi costs

## Question

Since the change of Prime Minister on 14 September, 2015:

1. How much did each department/agency spend on taxis during the specified period?

## Answer

1. For the period 14 September 2015 to 31 January 2016, the Department of Education and Training spent $\$ 176,600.44$ (GST exclusive) on taxi costs. The table below provides a breakdown by each business group.
