Question

Since the change of Prime Minister on 14 September, 2015:

- 1. How much did each department/agency spend on taxis during the specified period? Provide a breakdown for each business group in each department/agency.
- 2. What are the reasons for taxi costs?

Answer

1. For the period 14 September 2015 to 31 January 2016, the Department of Education and Training spent \$176,600.44 (GST exclusive) on taxi costs. The table below provides a breakdown by each business group.
