ASQA: Fol Requests

Question

Since the change of Prime Minister on 14 September, 2015:

- 1. How many requests for documents under the FOI Act have been received?
- 2. Of these, how many documents have been determined to be deliberative documents?
- 3. Of those assessed as deliberative documents:
- (a) For how many has access to the document been refused on the basis that it would be contrary to the public interest?
- (b) For how many has a redacted document been provided?

Answer

The Australian Skills Quality Authority (ASQA) has provided the following response.

- 1. ASQA received 27 FOI requests between 14 September 2015 and 31 January 2016
- 2. In relation to five of the 27 requests, a total of 19 documents were identified as containing deliberative matter
- 3. Of the 19 documents containing deliberative matter:
 - a) ASQA refused to grant access to 16 documents. Refusal of access was partially due
 the fact that releasing the deliberative material would be contrary to the public
 interest; however other factors were also taken into account in making the
 determination.
 - b) ASQA released three documents with deliberative matter redacted on the basis that this redacted information would be contrary to the public interest to release.
