Question

Comcare - Corporate cars

Since the change of Prime Minister on 14 September, 2015:

1. How many cars are owned by each department/agency?
 - a. Where are the cars located?
 - b. What are the cars used for?
 - c. What is the cost of each car during the specified period?
 - d. How far did each car travel during the specified period?
2. How many cars are leased by each department/agency?
 - a. Where are the cars located?

 - d. How far did each car travel during the specified period?

Answer

1. Comcare owns two vehicles.
 - a. Car 1 is located at 121 Marcus Clarke Street Canberra ACT 2600 and car 2 is awaiting auction at Pickles 179 Gladstone St, Fyshwick ACT 2609.
 - b. Car 1 is used as a pool car for business related travel purposes. Car 2 is a van and used for the transportation of paper files and bulky items from warehouse to office.
 - c. Car 1 has cost \$782.88 and Car 2 has cost \$325.45. Costs are GST inclusive.
 - d. Car 1 travelled 1090km & Car 2 travelled 40km.
2. Comcare leases 13 vehicles from SG Fleet.
 - a.
 - Two cars are located at 121 Marcus Clarke Street, Canberra ACT 2601
 - Two cars are located at 477 Pitt Street, Sydney NSW 2000
 - One car is located at 47 Bolton Street, Newcastle 2300
 - Two cars are located at 410 Queen Street, Brisbane QLD 4000
 - Two cars are located at 1 King William Street, Adelaide SA 5000
 - Two cars are located at 535 Bourke Street, Melbourne VIC 3000
 - Two cars are located at 89 St Georges Terrace, Perth WA 6000
 - b. These vehicles are used for field work by work health and safety inspectors.
