Question

Departmental Upgrades

Since the change of Prime Minister on 14 September, 2015:

Has the department/agency engaged in any new refurbishments, upgrades or changes to their building or facilities?

- 1. If so, list these
- 2. If so, list the total cost for these changes
- 3. If so, list the itemised cost for each item of expenditure
- 4. If so, who conducted the works?
- 5. If so, list the process for identifying who would conduct these works
- 6. If so, when are the works expected to be completed?

Answer

- Since 14 September 2015, the Department of Employment has undertaken building works in properties at 140-180 City Walk Canberra (Garema Court) and 4 Spongolite Street, Beard (Storage Facility).
- 2. The cost of both buildings is shared with the Department of Education and Training. The Department's share of the cost is \$520,134.05.
- 3. The Department's share for Garema Court is: construction works \$400,000; consultants \$25,000, removalists \$25,000 and workstation installers \$50,000. The Storage Facility costs are: security systems \$10,425.85; minor fit-out works \$8,601 and electrical works \$1,109.20.
- 4. The building works were undertaken by: Rork Constructions, AMC Architects, WT Partnership, Balfrans Removals, Allied Pickfords (Canberra), UCI Pty Lyd, Schiavello Pty Ltd, CDS Security Ptd Ltd, Dexion Pty Ltd and Smart Energy Pty Ltd.
- 5. A tender process was conducted for the engagement of the vendors.
- 6. The building works undertaken at the Storage Facility were completed in December 2015. The works currently being undertaken at Garema Court are scheduled to be completed by March 2016.
