Answer

Stationery expenditure for the Minister's office for the period 14 September 2015 to 31 January 2016 is \$4,163.21, including envelopes, business cards, printing paper and general office supplies. No customised stationary has been requested.

Stationery expenditure for the Department of Employment for the period 14 September 2015 to 31 January 2016 is \$76,024.68.
