Question

WGEA - Workplace Assessments

Since the change of Prime Minister on 14 September, 2015:

- 1. How much has been spent on workplace ergonomic assessments?
- 1. List each item of expenditure and cost
- 2. Have any assessments, not related to an existing disability, resulted in changes to workplace equipment or set up?
- 3. If so, list each item of expenditure and cost related to those changes

Answer

- 1. For the period 14 September 2015 to 31 January 2016, the Workplace Gender Equality Agency has spent \$475 on ergonomic assessments for staff.
- 2. Home based ergonomic assessment for one employee with an approved work from home arrangement at a cost of \$475.
