#### FWO - Details of attendance at union events

Senator CAMERON: Can you provide details of what union events you have attended, what information you have provided and has the situation, that dreadful situation for apprentices, improved?

Ms McAlary-Smith: Certainly I can take that on notice.

### Answer

The Fair Work Ombudsman (FWO) engages with unions across a range of work. The Campaigns team met with the Construction, Forestry, Mining and Energy Union (CFMEU) in 2014 and the Shop, Distributive and Allied Employees Association (SDA) in 2015. As part of stakeholder engagement for the National Building and Construction Industry Campaign 2014-2015, the FWO wrote to the:
