Question

SWA - Government advertising

1. How much has been spent on government advertising (including job ads) since Additional Estimates in February, 2014? i. List each item of expenditure and cost ii. List the approving officer for each item iii. Detail the outlets that were paid for the advertising
2. What government advertising is planned for the rest of the financial year? i. List the total expected cost ii. List each item of expenditure and cost iii. List the approving officer for each item. iv. Detail the outlets that have been or will be paid for the advertising

Answer

1. Since Additional Estimates in February 2014, Safe Work Australia has expended \$1 144 on job advertising.
 - i. The Australian Public Service Commission (APSC) jobs annual subscription enables the agency to manage advertisements for job vacancies and run APSjobs reports.
 - ii. Approval for Safe Work Australia's APSC jobs subscription was provided by the Director of Communications and Publishing on 9 December 2013.
