Question

Unpaid entitlements

"Since 2007 how many dollars in unpaid entitlements has been paid to how many employees around Australia; a) In total, b) by State, and: c) by electorate?"

Answer

Over the period 1 January 2007 to 31 May 2014, 95 028 employees were paid \$1.125 billion in assistance for unpaid employment entitlements through the Fair Entitlements Guarantee (FEG) and General Employee Entitlements and Redundancy Scheme (GEERS) programmes.

A breakdown of entitlements paid by state is in the table below.
