**Question**

**Table sent to Treasury**

Senator CAMERON: So you sent that one graph. Was that the only graph you sent to Treasury? Sorry—the table. Ms Taylor: I will check that, Senator. But what we are specifically looking for from Treasury is advice on our calculation of the fifth year and that the projection that we have made is in accordance with what they would consider to be appropriate. So the only thing that we would send to Treasury would be those projections and presumably our methodology.

**Answer**

On 12 February 2014, the Department of Employment sent to the Treasury and a number of other agencies a table showing the industry distribution of the projected employment growth of 838,100 over the five years to November 2018 (as published in the 2014 edition of *Australian Jobs*) to seek their views on whether the industry breakdown was broadly consistent with their outlook for the economy going forward. This was the only table of employment projections sent to the Treasury.
