Senator Siewert asked on 3 June 2014 on proof Hansard page 47

Question

JSA provider fees

Senator SIEWERT: So how much goes to the JSAs for that six months? If it is in here, tell me. Ms Taylor: I will take that on notice. I do not have that breakdown. Senator SIEWERT: So it is not just that I could not find it in here? Ms Taylor: No. I could have just been looking in the wrong place. Ms Leon: It will depend, because some of it is Work for the Dole. It will depend if some of the Work for the Dole is actually tendered for by the JSA providers. So some of them might be just standalone Work for the Dole providers and some of them might be JSA providers who also seek to do Work for the Dole coordination. Senator SIEWERT: I understand the point that you are making. But, for the point of this exercise, could I have it broken down into what is the JSAs for the service provision for the six months, what is the Work for the Dole and what is for the wage subsidies. Ms Taylor: Certainly. Senator SIEWERT: And any of the top-line conditions that you already know, bearing in mind the discussion we have just had about the micro policy that attaches to the wage subsidies. That would be appreciated. That is separate, I presume, to the job relocation and the job commitment? Ms Taylor: Yes. Senator SIEWERT: Could you also give us a breakdown of that too, please. The table below provides a breakdown of the Stronger Participation Incentive for Job Seekers aged Under 30 Budget measure by discrete element:
