Moving to floating indexation rate from 2018

Question

I want to go to the issue of the indexation of the SRS. Could you give us an indication of how much moving to the floating indexation rate in 2018, 2019 and 2020 would cost? Is that something you can model easily?

Answer

Moving immediately to a floating composite indexation rate as set out in the Australian Education Amendment Bill is estimated to save \$880 million over 4 years and \$3.0 billion over 10 years when a 3 per cent floor is applied, and \$1.5 billion over 4 years and \$4.9 billion over 10 years when the floor is removed.
