Schools funding

Question

Please break down the \$18.6 billion package by school year, state and sector.

Answer

The 2017–18 Budget provided an additional \$18.6 billion in Commonwealth recurrent funding for schools from 2018 to 2017. This amount has been updated following passage of the Australian Education Amendment Bill 2017. An additional \$23.4 billion in Commonwealth recurrent funding will now be provided from 2018 to 2027, compared to the 2016–17 Budget. The following table provides a breakdown by state/territory and sector.

Note: state and territory allocations in the 2016–17 Budget from the 2018 school year onwards were indicative only and subject to consultation between the Commonwealth, the states and territories, and the non-government sector.
