#### *AMEP and SEE programs - student number in each region*

#### Question

How many AMEP and SEE students are expected in each region in each of the next five years?

#### Answer

The number of students expected to commence in the Adult Migrant English Program (AMEP) and Skills for Education and Employment (SEE) program are outlined in the 2017–18 Portfolio Budget Statement.

Program	2017–18	2018–19	2019–20	2020–2021
