### ARC - International collaborations

CHAIR: What is the collaboration internationally? Prof. Byrne: The international collaborations are actually enormous. A lot of our programs involve overseas researchers. There is a very high fraction. I cannot remember it off the top of my head, but it is over 50 per cent. CHAIR: Could you let us know? Prof. Byrne: We will provide the number of international researchers for our discovery programs. It is quite extraordinary.

### **Answer**

The Australian Research Council has provided the following response.

Of the total of 703 Discovery Projects grants awarded for funding commencing in 2014:

- 443 (or 63 % of total grants) involved international collaboration
- 293 (or 41.7 % of total grants) involved at least one international partner investigator.
