Question

Australian Public Service Commission capability review for the Department of Education, Employment and Workplace Relations

Senator CAMERON: How long does a capability review take? Ms Leon: I think it is about two or three months, but I would stand to be corrected by the Public Service Commission as to the details. Senator CAMERON: I suppose each department could be different. Ms Leon: Yes, the Department of Education, Employment and Workplace Relations is a large department and that might take longer to do than a smaller department. But it is in the vicinity of a few months. Senator CAMERON: On notice, can you provide me with details of how long the capability review took for this department. Ms Leon: Yes, I can take that on notice.

Answer

In the former Department of Education, Employment and Workplace Relations the capability review team spent three months in the department undertaking the review.
