Question

Earnings: Electrotechnology and Telecommunications Trade worker

1. How much more will an Electrotechnology and Telecommunications Trade worker with a Certificate III or IV qualification earn than a non-graduate over a working lifetime?
2. How much more will an Electrotechnology and Telecommunications Trade worker with a Certificate III or IV qualification earn than a graduate over a working lifetime?
3. How much more will an Electrotechnology and Telecommunications Trade worker with a Certificate III or IV qualification earn than a school teacher over a working lifetime?
4. How much more will an Electrotechnology and Telecommunications Trade worker with a Certificate III or IV qualification earn than a nurse over a working lifetime?

Answer

The Department of Education is not aware of any research that estimates these earnings differentials.
