**Dept & All Agencies: Stationery Requirements**

Since Budget Estimates in June, 2014: 1. How much has been spent by each department and agency on the government (Ministers / Parliamentary Secretaries) stationery requirements in your portfolio to date? a. Detail the items provided to the minister's office. b. Please specify how many reams of paper have been supplied to the Minister's office. 2. How much has been spent on departmental stationery requirements to date. 3. Has any customised stationery been requested or provided to the Minister or Ministerial Staff? If yes, please include a photo/scan, detail the type of stationery, date it was requested, date it was provided and the cost.

**Answer**

For the period 1 July 2014 to 31 October 2014:

1. \$11,073. Items included envelopes, business cards, with compliments slips, general office supplies and 244 reams of paper.
