TEQSA: accreditation

Senator RHIANNON: Has there been any increase in the number of inquiries you have received about accreditation? You described in an earlier response that you are getting about 30 to 40 inquiries for new providers. I just wanted to check over what period that was and whether that is fairly normal or is going up? Prof. Saunders: As I said, in the last 12 months we have had 30 to 40 inquiries, which have ranged from very brief inquiries through to some quite detailed discussion. At the moment we are receiving about one new applications for course accreditations at about 10 a month, and it was 10 a month last financial year. Senator RHIANNON: Did you see a spike after the budget? Prof. Saunders: To my knowledge, no, but I will take that on notice and get back to you.
