Question

FWC - Staffing - recruitment

Since Budget Estimates in June, 2014:

- 1. How many ongoing staff have been recruited? What classification are these staff?
- 2. How many non-ongoing positions exist or have been created? What classification are these staff?
- 3. How many staff have been employed on contract and what is the average length of their employment period?

Answer

- 1. For the period 1 July 2014 until 31 October 2014 no ongoing employees have been recruited on an ongoing basis. Two ongoing employees have been recruited from other APS agencies on a temporary basis (1 x Executive Level 1, 1 x Executive Level 2).
- 2. The Fair Work Commission employed 48 non-ongoing employees as at 31 October 2014. Seventeen non-ongoing employees have commenced since 1 July 2014 (1 x APS Level 3, 9 x APS Level 4, 5 x APS Level 5, 1 x Executive Level 1, 1 x Executive Level 2).
- 3. Based on account records received for the period 1 July 2014 until 31 October 2014, eleven persons have been employed on contract via external recruitment agencies and the average length of their employment is 3.8 weeks.
