Question

FWBC - Staffing

1. How many people does FWBC employ? How has that changed since 30 June 2014? Please provide details of any changes? 2. What is the number of staff employed by FWBC in each state and territory? 3. Please provide details by function of the number of staff employed, the age, gender and APS classification of staff employed in the function?

Answer

1. At 31 October 2014 FWBC employed 150 staff. This number includes staff currently on long term leave. At 30 June 2014 there were 133 staff employed at FWBC. Twenty new staff members have commenced with the agency and three staff have left the agency.
