## Question

## Fair Entitlements Guarantee - payments

How many people have received a FEG payment this from its inception until now? Of those recipients, what is the dollar figure is received? - Can the Department please provide the Committee a number and dollar break down by state, territory and electorate? - Can the Department provide the age of the recipients?

## Answer

The department has paid 19,073 people a total amount of $\$ 337.1$ million since the Fair Entitlements Guarantee commenced on 5 December 2012 (data to 20 November 2014).

A breakdown of entitlements paid by state and age is provided in Attachment A. This data is not collected by electorate.
