### **Answer**

This question was answered in full in Budget Estimates 2014–2015, 4 June 2014. SQ14-000979 provided a comprehensive table and breakdown of the number of chaplains and their faiths for the National School Chaplaincy and Student Welfare Programme (NSCSWP) which ran from 2012–2014.
