MoG: movement of early childhood

Question

In relation to the movement of early childhood functions from the Department of Education to the Department of Social Services and back again:

a) Why was early childhood originally moved out of the Department of Education and into Social Services?

b) Why was early childhood moved back into the Department of Education?

c) What was the total cost of moving early childhood from the Department of Education into the Department of Social Services?

d) What was the total cost of moving early childhood from the Department of Social Service back to the Department of Education?

e) If the justification for moving child care policy to DSS was to "get the focus of government particularly on to jobs and families", does that mean that is no longer the government's focus?

f) In February the Department gave evidence that:

"the substance of the changes that occurred with the machinery of government was in relation to the family support around child care, which is going back to how historically it has been more closely administered by the social services portfolio."

If that was the case in February, what has changed?

g) How many staff moved to the Department of Social Services as a result of the previous MoG?

h) When was the transfer of staff earlier this year completed? That is, when did the last of the staff physically relocate to DSS?

i) How many of those staff will come back into DoE? When will the move commence and how long will it take?

j) Where had those staff previously been located when they were last in DoE? What had happened to those premises in the intervening period – had the Department of Education disposed of surplus office space?

k) Will early childhood staff move back to the same DoE location? If not, where will they be accommodated? Will new premises need to be leased?

I) Will those staff require new business cards or can they use their old ones?

m) How many days did staff spend in their new Canberra DSS accommodation before the Government announced they would be moved back to DoE?

n) In relation to staff movements outside Canberra:

i. In how many locations did staff move from DoE to DSS? What were those locations? How many staff were involved in each of those moves and what was the total cost of each move, including any break-lease fees?

ii. Was any office space left empty after staff moved from DoE to DSS? Where is this located? How many square metres in each location? What was the cost of leasing the empty office space?

iii. In how many locations will staff have to move from DSS to DoE? What are those locations? How many staff will be involved in each move? What is the expected cost of each move? Will any new property need to be leased - what will the cost of that be in each location?

iv. Are any staff going to move back into the same DoE accommodation they vacated to move to DSS? If so, in which locations will this occur?

NOTE – Please liaise with the Department of Social Services to ensure figures reflect the total costs across both agencies.

- k) Returning National Office staff will be located in Civic. In Sydney, Brisbane and Alice Springs, staff will be accommodated under hosting arrangements with DSS, the Department of Prime Minister and Cabinet and the Department of Health. No new leases will be required.
