# Child care safety net - indigenous children investment

### Question

In the child care safety net, what level of investment has been allocated for indigenous children in each year of the forwards? How many children will this cater for?

#### Answer

The Child Care Safety Net has not been disaggregated by specific cohorts of children, including Indigenous children.

The Child Care Safety Net will provide \$858 million over the forward estimates to assist disadvantaged or vulnerable families and children, which is expected to include families from Indigenous backgrounds.

A key element of the Child Care Safety Net is the Community Child Care Fund, which will support child care service providers in disadvantaged communities to address a range of access, affordability, locational and socio-cultural barriers to child care, including in Indigenous communities.

Also as part of the Community Child Care Fund, \$10 million a year will specifically support the integration of child care, maternal and child health and family support services in a number of disadvantaged Indigenous communities, as recommended by the Forrest Review of Indigenous Jobs and Training, *Creating Parity*.
