Adult Migrant English Program - AMEP English language tuition

Question

What ongoing monitoring and reporting processes is the government establishing to assure the public of the quality and effectiveness of the AMEP English language tuition entitlement for newly arrived refugee and migrants under the new contact arrangements?

Answer

- All Adult Migrant English Program (AMEP) clients will be assessed against the Australian Core Skills Framework on entry to AMEP, at every 200 hours of tuition thereafter and on exit of AMEP.
- AMEP service providers will be contractually bound to meet a set level of client progression through outcome-focussed Key Performance Indicators.
