Investigation into the Bruce Hardwig Flying School

Question

Senator XENOPHON: Dr Banerjee, under the rules of parliamentary privilege it really does not matter if there is a matter before the courts. Nothing we say here is adducible in the court anyway, or before a tribunal. Did the department undertake an investigation into the Bruce Hardwig Flying School last year?

Ms Quagliata: It depends what you mean by 'investigation', in that of course we looked into it. We were getting complaints and we did look into it. There was no formal investigation, if you mean that there were terms of reference and specific people allocated to interview students or things like that.

Senator XENOPHON: Were any reports or memoranda prepared about the complaints that had been received?

Ms Quagliata: There were file notes and there were discussions, but there was no formal report.

Senator XENOPHON: Would you be able to provide the committee a copy of those file notes and notes of any discussions?

Ms Quagliata: Yes.
