## **Question:**

**Senator RONALDSON**—Did anyone at Government House see the invitation? **Ms Prendergast**—I cannot answer for other people. I would have to take that on notice. **Senator RONALDSON**—Can you take on notice, please, as to whether Government House ticked-off on them? I cannot imagine that you would allow an invitation to be sent out under the Governor-General's name without your seeing the invitation but if you say you are not sure, can you take that on notice? Can you provide me with a copy of that invitation? Can you provide me with details of every one of those people who were officially invited on behalf of the Governor-General?

## Answer:

Further to the additional information provided to the committee on 17 March 2011, the Office issued three messages of invitation to Long Tan veterans and their spouses. The first, a letter dated 10 May 2010, was to the Former Commander of D Company, Harry Smith, advising that the Governor-General proposed to host a ceremony at Government House to invest individual honours recipients (Harry Smith, David Sabin and Geoff Kendall, and a representative of the late Clifford Dohle). This was followed by an email on 7 July 2010 to Mr Smith advising of the Governor-General's proposal to host an investiture ceremony to present the individual honours and the Unit Citation for Gallantry (UCG) emblem to Long Tan veterans on 17 August 2010. As the Office did not have contact details for the relevant veterans, Mr Smith undertook to have the Long Tan Veterans Association prepare a list of veterans who would likely attend. On 5 August 2010, the Office contacted the President of the Veterans Association, John Hesslewood, to confirm the details of the Governor-General's invitation to the group.

The letter of 10 May 2010 and the email of 7 July 2010 were sent by the Deputy Official Secretary, Mark Fraser. The email of 5 August 2010 was sent by the Operations Manager, Paul Singer.

The Office was provided a list of names by the Department of Defence Directorate of Honours and Awards, of 127 Long Tan veterans (including 28 deceased persons) entitled to the Unit Citation for Gallantry with Federation Star. A copy of the list follows over the next 3 pages.
