## **Answer:**

Average staffing levels of the general-government sector are published annually in the Budget. Updated average staffing levels for 2014-15, as well as forecasts for 2015-16, will be published in the 2015-16 Budget.

The Australian Public Service Commission also publishes headcount staffing information on staff employed under the *Public Service Act 1999*, biannually. The latest data, released on 10 March 2015, has the total number of staff employed under the *Public Service Act 1999* at 152.606 as at 31 December 2014.
