Senator LUDWIG: What level do you estimate, though, for wage growth? Is there a parameter that you put into your modelling?

Mr Thomann: It is Social Services who would have that in their model. I am not sure that they actually have that particular parameter in the model. I will have to take that on notice in terms of what is actually in the model. But certainly what they are modelling is a combination of what they are seeing in terms of the wages that they are seeing and the actuals of what people are claiming in relation to what is their family income.

Ms Halton: I think we are getting to a level of specifics here in terms of what is in the model. We will have to have a look at it.

Answer:
