Question:

1. How many mobile phones are in use by Finance employees?

- 2. With which telecommunications service provider are Finance mobile phones linked to?
- 3. What is the cost of the plan for each mobile phone?
- 4. How much data is included in this plan?
- 5. What is the cost if data usage goes beyond its quota?
- 6. Have there been instances where data usage for individual mobile phone users has exceeded its quota? If so, can the Department detail the costs incurred as a result for the 2014-15 financial year, and the 2015-16 financial year to date.

Answer:

- 1. There are 232 mobile phones actively used by Finance employees.
- 2. Finance uses Telstra as its mobile phone service provider.
- 3-5. The Department utilises multiple plans offered as part of the WoG Panel for Telecommunications Carriage, Commodities and Associated Services. The majority of Finance staff utilise a \$40 plan with 2GB available data, excess data usage is calculated at \$0.25 per MB, and charged by KB.
- 6. The department's expense management system does not provide the details requested. It would involve an unreasonable diversion of departmental resources to seek to answer this question.
