1. Can the Department provide an update of the work being done on the Finance portfolio charging review?

- 2. Which services or activities within the Finance portfolio are subject to charging under the Australian Government Charging Framework?
- 3. Which services or activities within the Finance portfolio are subject to cost-recovery activities?
- 4. Which services or activities within the Finance portfolio are not subject to charging or cost-recovery activities?

Answer:

- 1. Finance completed its portfolio charging review during late 2015 and early 2016, and provided the outcomes of the review to the Finance Minister.
- 2. Two activities have been identified as subject to charging under the Australian Government Charging Framework, being COMCAR Ground Transport for Guest of Government Visits (Department of Finance), and Fee-for-service elections (Australian Electoral Commission).
- 3. Both of the above activities are cost-recovery activities under the framework.
- 4. All other activities in the portfolio are funded either through appropriations or charging of other Government bodies.
