

Question: 159
Topic: Allocation of car parks

Senator WONG asked:

- 1 How many staff of the Parliamentary Budget Office are allocated a car park at Parliament House?
- 2 Please detail each position entitled to a car park and the location of this car park.
- 3 Who makes the decision about who is entitled to an allocated car park?
- 4 Who makes the decision on the location of these parks?

Answer

- 1 The Parliamentary Budget Office (PBO) has seven reserved car parks. One is located in the Senators Only car park and six are in the Senate car park.
- 2 The Parliamentary Budget Officer is entitled to a car park in the Senators Only car park.
- 3 The President of the Senate formalised the reserved spaces for the Parliamentary Budget Office on 25 June 2015, specifying that the Parliamentary Budget Officer has an allocated space in the Senators Only car park and that there are six reserved spaces in the general Senate car park for the PBO. These six spaces are allocated by the Parliamentary Budget Officer to the PBO senior executive staff.
- 4 The locations of PBO's reserved car parks are approved by the President of the Senate.
