#### **Answer**

- 1. Not applicable. The Library provides services to the Parliament on the basis of equality of access for all Senators and Members.
- 2. Media monitoring costs are incurred by DPS for services provided to the Parliament.
  - a. iSentia Pty Limited and Sentiment Metrics.
  - b. From 14 September 2015 to 31 January 2016, the Library has spent \$97,355 (GST excl.) on media monitoring services.
  - c. This fee includes:
    - i. press clips from the major national and metropolitan newspapers for the; Parliamentary Library's newspaper clippings database in ParlInfo (iSentia); and
    - ii. access to iSentia's Mediaportal which includes a 180 day archive of regional newspapers.
