1. How many staff of the Department of Parliamentary Services are allocated a government car parking pass?
2. Please detail each position entitled to a car parking pass and the category of this pass.
3. How many allocated car parks are there for government pass holders at Parliament House and what is the location of these car parks?
4. Can holders of government car park passes park in the public car park at no cost?

**Answer**

1. The following eight DPS SES officers have Government Vehicle Parking Permits, which are managed and administered by the ACT Government Road Transport Authority:
  - Parliamentary Librarian
  - Chief Information Officer
  - Chief Operating Officer
  - First Assistant Secretary, Building and Asset Management
  - Chief Financial Officer
  - Assistant Secretary, ICT Strategy, Planning and Applications
  - Assistant Secretary, ICT Infrastructure and Services
  - Assistant Secretary, Business Continuity Project
2. The Secretary and all DPS SES officers are entitled to a Government Vehicle Parking Permit.
3. House of Representatives Private Parliamentarian Car Park - 34 Reserved Class B  
House of Representatives Private Car Park - 9 Reserved Class B and 18 Members of Parliament Sitting Days Only  
Senate Private Parliamentarian Car Park - 32 Reserved Class B  
Senate Private Car Park - 0  
Public Car Park – 24 Reserved Class B  
Ministerial Car Parks:
  - Razorblades West - 10;
  - Razorblades East - 0;
  - Ministerial Ground Floor East - 10;
  - Ministerial Ground Floor West - 8;
