Are you able to outline the funding around the Chronic Disease Package?

**Answer:**

The Indigenous Australians' Health Programme (IAHP) includes a strong focus on the prevention, detection and management of chronic disease. The IAHP has been funded \$3.3 billion over four years, from 2015-16. This includes \$729.135 million in 2015-16. A range of chronic disease activities are funded under the IAHP, as indicated in the following table.
