## Question:

Senator WONG: Page 23 has the additional estimates and variations. There is $\$ 4.3$ million, $\$ 8.1$ million, $\$ 8.3$ million, $\$ 8.45$ million and $\$ 8.5$ million for the out years. It is the reasonable chunk of money. So that is a new measure?
Ms Owens: It is a new measure, but it is offset by reductions in departmental funding across the Commonwealth.
Senator WONG: Perhaps you can provide on notice where it was offset from.
Ms Owens: Sure.

## Answer:

Offsets have been reallocated from Commonwealth portfolios based on the extent to which they are likely to use the openly available G-NAF.
