Will the COAG Advisory Panel report advise of practical measures for criminalising revenge porn?

**Answer:**

The COAG Advisory Panel ('the Panel') conducted consultations with a range of stakeholders who have a particular expertise in responding to domestic violence and sexual assault. These consultations included consideration of concerns about the distribution of intimate material without consent.

The outcomes of these consultations have informed the Panel's deliberations. The Panel will provide their final report to COAG at its first meeting in 2016.
