Answer:

The complete list of current National Partnership Agreements and Project Agreements (which are captured in the definition of National Partnerships) related to Indigenous affairs is as follows:

- National Partnership on Stronger Futures in the Northern Territory (will be replaced by the National Partnership on Northern Territory Remote Aboriginal Investment currently under negotiation)
- National Partnership on Remote Indigenous Housing (will be replaced by the National Partnership on Remote Housing currently under negotiation)
- Project Agreement on Improving Trachoma Control Services for Indigenous Australians
- Project Agreement for the Rheumatic Fever Strategy (SA) and as a schedule to the National Partnership on Specified Projects (Qld, WA and NT)
- Project Agreement for Renal Infrastructure in the Northern Territory (Family Centric Renal Accommodation)
- National Partnership on Universal Access to Early Childhood Education – 2016 and 2017.
