With reference to the current contract arrangements with the licensee of Aussie's Café:

1. If the contract is on a month-to-month basis, what termination arrangements apply?
2. Is there a relevant period of notice?
3. Do any compensatory provisions exist?

Answer

1. Either party may give one month's notice to the other party to terminate the Licence Agreement.
2. One month.
3. There are no compensatory provisions relating to the month to month termination arrangement in the Licence Agreement.
